## SCHEDULE

### DETERMINATION OF PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENCE APPLICATIONS OF BENCHMARK ADMINISTRATORS

#### 1. Definitions

In this Schedule “**the Act**” means the Financial Sector Regulation Act, 2017 (Act No. 9 of 2017) and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act has the meaning so assigned to it unless a different meaning is assigned elsewhere in this Schedule;

“**Authority**” means the Financial Sector Conduct Authority established in terms of section 56 of the Act;

“**benchmark administrator**” has the meaning assigned to it in the Designation of Benchmarks Regulations, [-] published in Notice No.[-] Government Gazette No. [-] in terms of sections 3(3) and (5) and 288 of the Act.

#### 2. Application to be licenced as a benchmark administrator

A person who applies for a licence as a benchmark administrator under section 111(2) of the Act, must submit a written application to the Authority consisting of the following duly completed documentation—

- (a) Form 1: Declaration by the Chief Executive Officer or duly authorised representative.
- (b) Form 2: Application index to be completed by the benchmark administrator.
- (c) Form 3: Application form to be completed in respect of members of a governing body, senior managers, or oversight committee members of a benchmark administrator; and
- (d) Form 4: Application form to be completed in respect of the business of benchmark administrator.
